This one-day programme focuses on providing a better understanding on Bursa Malaysia Sustainability Reporting Requirements and on Sustainability Reporting in general. As per 2018 all Bursa listed companies need to include sustainability reporting in their annual reports.

The program is designed for staff that has a role to play in the development and the management of the sustainability measures of the organization. In essence every department of the organization has some involvement in the overall sustainability effort and representatives of these departments should have a basic understanding of Sustainability and Sustainability Reporting
